

ORDINANCE NO. 2013-002

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING BURNING OF FIELDS WITHIN THE CITY

WHEREAS, the burning of agricultural and other fields within the City is ultrahazardous and creates a danger of fire for the persons and property of inhabitants, a risk of vehicle accidents due to vision obsurement from smoke, and potential respiratory problems for inhabitants.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TYRONZA, ARKANSAS, AS FOLLOWS:

Sec. 1: That the burning of agricultural and other fields within the city limits by, or on behalf of, the owner or occupant is prohibited.

Sec. 2: That each violation of this ordinance is punishable by a fine of \$100.00, and each field in which such activity is carried on, and each day a violation continues, shall constitute a separate offense.

Sec. 3: That as the open burning of agricultural and other fields is an ultrahazardous activity creating a danger to persons and property within the City, this Ordinance is necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and it shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
